Ex 21:22-25

²² "If men fight, and hurt a woman with child, so that she gives birth prematurely, yet no harm follows, he shall surely be punished accordingly as the woman's husband imposes on him and he shall pay as the judges *determine*.

4. NOT ACKNOWLEDGING THINE INIQUITY

Jere 3:13

¹³ Only acknowledge your iniquity, That you have transgressed against the LORD your God, And have scattered your charms To alien deities under every green tree, And you have not obeyed My voice,' says the LORD.

5. ADULTERY

Mt 19:18

¹⁸ He said to Him, "Which ones?" Jesus said, "**'You shall not murder,' 'You shall not commit adultery,' 'You shall not steal,' 'You shall not bear false witness,'**

Gen 39:7-9

⁷ And it came to pass after these things that his master's wife cast longing eyes on Joseph, and she said, "Lie with me."

⁸ But he refused and said to his master's wife, "Look, my master does not know what *is* with me in the house, and he has committed all that he has to my hand.

Penalty for both involved is death

Deut 22:22

¹⁰ 'The man who commits adultery with *another* man's wife, *he* who commits adultery with his neighbor's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress, shall surely be put to death.

¹¹ The man who lies with his father's wife has uncovered his father's nakedness both of them shall surely be put to death. Their blood *shall be* upon them.

¹² If a man lies with his daughter-in-law, both of them shall surely be put to death. They have committed perversion. Their blood *shall be* upon them.

643. TAKING AWAY FROM THE WORDS OF THIS PROPHECY

Rev 22:19

¹⁹ and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book.

644. TO BE DESTITUTE OF THE TRUTH

1 Tim 6:5

⁵ useless wranglings of men of corrupt minds and destitute of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a *means of gain*. From such withdraw yourself.

645. TO ERR CONCERNING THE TRUTH

2 Tim 2:18

¹⁸ who have strayed concerning the truth, saying that the resurrection is already

past; and they overthrow the faith of some.

646. TRYING TO ENTER HEAVEN BY A WAY OTHER THAN THE GOSPEL'S WAY

Jn 10:1-7

- ¹ "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.
- ² But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep.
- ³ To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

- ³¹ He who comes from above is above all; he who is of the earth is earthly and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all.

1 Jn 4:5,6

- ⁵ They are of the world. Therefore they speak *as* of the world, and the world hears them.
⁶ We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error.

661. SORROW OF THE WORLD

2 Cor 7:10

662. WORLDLY AMBITION

666. LETTING THE SUN GO DOWN ON YOUR WRATH

Eph 4:26

²⁶ **"Be angry, and do not sin"**: do not let the sun go down on your wrath,

¹³ but exhort one another daily, while it is called **"Today,"** lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

667. YOUNGER, NOT SUBMITTING TO THE ELDER

⁵ Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to *your* elders. Yes, all of *you* be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for **"God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."**
